<p>Provide a welcoming atmosphere to all our families but we will not be able shake your hand just yet! Staff will wear face masks to help keep you safe.</p> <p>Provide an environment which has been risk assessed in response to COVID19 infection and the Local Authority Risk Assessment. Adhere to the social distancing rules as set out by the Government as much as we possibly can.</p> <p>Provide a curriculum that meets the needs of your child's well-being, mental health and academic needs.</p> <p>Contact parents /carers if your child displays any symptoms of COVID 19.</p> <p>Inform you if staff or children in your child's bubble test positive for COVID 19 so that you are aware to self-isolate.</p> <p>In the case of you having to self-isolate remote learning is in place for your child.</p> <p>Continue our clear and consistent approach to rewards and sanctions for children as set out in the Behaviour Policy as well as the expectations outlines in this agreement.</p> <p>Communicate between home, and school through notices, newsletters, text and email. You will also be able to access all information on the school website.</p>	<p>If my child or anyone in my household shows symptoms of COVID19, I will not send them to school. I will get them tested and I will let school know as soon as possible via telephone.</p> <p><i>If my child shows symptoms of COVID19 at school I will collect my child immediately. I will get them tested as soon as possible and let school know via telephone.</i></p> <p>On my commute and when dropping or picking my child up I will adhere to the 2m social distancing rule.</p> <p><i>When I drop my child off I will not congregate by school gates. I will keep a safe distance and I will wear a facemask when on school premises. If I am exempt from wearing a mask I will inform school.</i></p> <p>My child will not bring any items into school from home or take items home from school.</p> <p><i>I will not be allowed to come into school without a pre-arranged appointment via telephone or email.</i></p> <p>I understand that my child needs to attend school on March 8th and that attendance will be monitored. If my child is ill I will ring school to explain the reason for absence.</p> <p><i>I will read all letters/messages and emails that are sent home and support staff to have "a safe as possible" environment.</i></p> <p>I will inform school of any changes to parent/carers and emergency contact numbers.</p> <p><i>I understand that if there is evidence that I have not followed social distancing, my child may lose their place at school.</i></p>	<p>Follow the bubble rules that keep me safe.</p> <p>Wash my hands as soon as I go into school.</p> <p>Tell an adult if I feel unwell.</p> <p>Not bring things into school from home or take things home from school.</p> <p>Only use my own equipment that school provides. Not mix with any other children in the school that are not in my bubble.</p> <p>Follow the "catch it, bin it, kill it" rules coughing and sneezing into the elbow or tissue.</p> <p>Regularly wash my hands using soap and water for 20 seconds.</p> <p>Follow rules at all times to maintain the safety of myself and others.</p> <p>Follow these expectations and know that if I don't I will be sent home and will not be able to come back into school until I can be safe.</p> <p>Remember READY, RESPECTFUL, SAFE</p>
