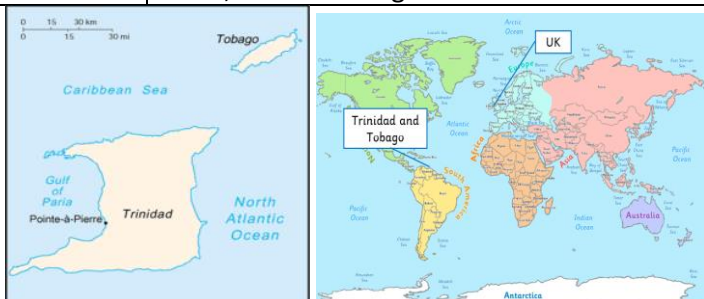
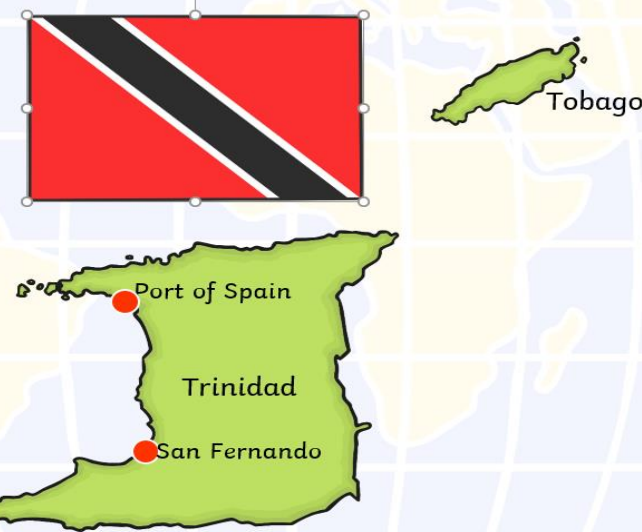
How are Runcorn and Pointe-a-Pierre the same or different?

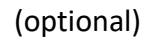
