Provides a chance to:

- Meet others who understand

- Learn about the tactics/behaviours used to control
- Work out how to be safer
- Understand why it may be hard to leave
- Consider options and choices

Why this course:

During controlling relationships people often feel:

- Powerless because they can't stop the abuse
- Confused because it doesn't make sense
- Angry or hurt because it shouldn't be happening
- Guilty because they think they have done something wrong
- Afraid of their partner's anger
- Ashamed because they think they are allowing this to happen
- Alone because they think it is only happening to them

Ever ask yourself... ?

"If this is love, why does it hurt?"

"Why do I put up with this?"

"What can I do to stay safe?"

"Who would I go to for help?"

"Is it my fault?"

"How can I support my family?"

"Why does this happen to me?"

"How can it be abuse if I have never been hit?"

"Am I the only one?"

"If I change will things get better?"
