

Look at the image of Jack in the van looking dismal. How is he feeling at this moment in time? Present tense. How do we know? Discuss how the illustrator has emphasised Jack's feelings. Focus on illustrator's technique of show not tell by children freeze-framing Jack's body language at this point. Use Magic Microphone to really understand how Jack feels. Ensure children explain how they are feeling (as Jack) at this moment-present tense. Their explanation as to why they feel like that will use the past tense e.g . I feel really cross with myself because I used all of mum's money to buy some useless beans.
