The Sound /or/ Spelt 'a'

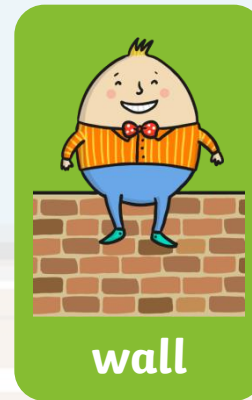

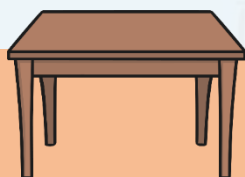
