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Story plan – Jack and the Baked Beanstalk

| <u>Beginning</u> | Jack and his mum run their own Fast Food Van. The council decide to build a flyover and the road to Jack's café is closed. |
| <u>Build-up</u> | The new flyover stops people from visiting Jack's Fast Food Van. They decide that they can make coffee for people, so Jack is sent to the shop to buy some milk and coffee beans. Jack buys magic beans instead of coffee beans |
| <u>Problem</u> | Jack's mum is furious. She throws the magic beans out of the window. A beanstalk grows during the night. Jack climbs the beanstalk and meets a friendly giant who likes counting money. He would like Jack to stay so that he has a friend. |
| <u>Resolution</u> | Jack does not stay and the giant lets his chicken and radio go down the beanstalk with Jack. The giant waves goodbye and suddenly falls down the beanstalk too. He is worried he will have nothing to do if he stays with Jack as he has no money to count. |
| <u>Ending</u> | The giant and Jack make a new café called the Baked Beanstalk Café . It is a roaring success and they are all very happy. |

| <u>Beginning</u> | <p>Jack and his mum run their own Fast Food Van. The council decide to build a flyover and the road to Jack's café is closed. Jack and his mum own their own sweet shop. The council decide to build a new shopping centre with its own big sweet shop.</p> |
| <u>Build-up</u> | <p>The new shopping centre stops people from visiting Jack's Sweet Shop. They decide that they can make chocolate bars for people, so Jack is sent to the market to buy some cocoa beans. He buys magic beans in a cup instead of cocoa beans.</p> |
| <u>Problem</u> | <p>Jack's mum is furious. She throws the magic beans out of the window. A beanstalk grows during the night. Jack climbs the beanstalk and meets a sad giant who likes singing songs and building with his golden bricks. <i>Fee fo fo fum</i> <i>I am sad and there's work to be done</i> <i>I build and build all day long</i> <i>But I just want a friend</i> <i>To sing me a song.</i> He would like Jack to stay so that he is not as lonely.</p> |
| <u>Resolution</u> | <p>Jack does not stay and the giant gives him some golden bricks. The giant waves goodbye with a tear in his eye. The giant trips and falls down the beanstalk too. He is worried he will have nothing to do if he stays with Jack as he has no bricks to build with.</p> |
| <u>Ending</u> | <p>The giant and Jack make a new shop called Singing Cocoa Heaven. It is a roaring success and they are all very happy.</p> |
